GREETINGS:

To either of the Constables of the Town of Swansea,

In the name of the Commonwealth you are hereby required to notify and warn the inhabitants of said Town who are qualified to vote in elections and Town affairs to meet at the JOSEPH CASE HIGH SCHOOL, 70 SCHOOL STREET, Swansea, Massachusetts, on MONDAY, the **FOURTEENTH (14th)** day of **JUNE**, at **SEVEN-O'CLOCK P.M.**, then and there to act on the following articles in the warrant:

Article 1: To see if the Town will vote to raise, appropriate or transfer a sum not to exceed \$4,074.50 to pay an old bill to Fuss and O'Neil, Inc., for the purposes of compiling and completing a grant application to the Municipal Vulnerability Preparedness Action Grant program, or take any other action relative thereto.

Article 2: To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds a sum not to exceed \$10,000 to repair the roofs of the buildings at the little league baseball fields, or take any other action relative thereto.

Article 3: To see if the Town will vote to transfer from available funds a sum not to exceed \$50,000 to purchase sand for the feeder beach and shells for the beach parking lot, or take any other action relative thereto.




And you are hereby directed to serve this warrant by posting attested copies thereof fourteen (14) days at least before the day of said meeting as prescribed by law.


