

## TOWN OF SWANSEA SPECIAL TOWN MEETING JUNE 14, 2021

\*Original date: May 17, 2021

The Special Town Meeting held in and for the Town of Swansea, MA on June 14, 2021, was held in accordance with the General Laws of Massachusetts and the By-Laws of the Town of Swansea, with the rules of the meeting further governed by Town Meeting Time and Robert's Rules of Order, the Warrant and the Advisory & Finance Board recommendations duly posted, a quorum present, and all procedural requirements being met.

The meeting held at the Joseph Case High School, 70 School Street, Swansea, MA was called to order by the Moderator Paul C. Burke at 7:00 PM. At the opening of the meeting, there were 82 voters present.

A motion was made and seconded to waive the reading of the warrant. Motion carried unanimously.

**Article 1 VOTED**: That the Town vote to raise, appropriate or transfer a sum not to exceed \$4,074.50 to pay an old bill to Fuss and O'Neil, Inc., for the purposes of compiling and completing a grant application to the Municipal Vulnerability Preparedness Action Grant program, or take any other action relative thereto.

**A&F Recommendation:** approval by Unanimous Vote.

- Motion carried unanimously.

**Article 2 VOTED:** That the Town vote to transfer from available funds a sum not to exceed \$10,000 to repair the roofs of the buildings at the little league baseball fields, or take any other action relative thereto.

**A&F Recommendation: approval by Unanimous Vote.** 

- Motion carried unanimously.

**Article 3 VOTED**: That the Town vote to transfer from available funds a sum not to exceed \$50,000 to purchase sand for the feeder beach and shells for the beach parking lot, or take any other action relative thereto.

**A&F Recommendation:** approval by Unanimous Vote.

- Motion carried unanimously.

A motion was made and seconded to adjourn the Special Town Meeting at 7:08 PM.
